NOTES

1. If you need transport to the beach for patrol duties - please contact your patrol captain prior to your weekends patrol.
2. Uniforms for each patrol will be provided and kept at the clubhouse. These will be washed at the end of the weekend for the next patrol. Please do not take uniforms home - as there are limited numbers and we need enough for each weekend.
3. All lifeguard shirts **MUST** be the new shirts with SLSNZ Sponsor State Insurance printed on it. If you have an old shirt please return this to your patrol captain so they can be returned to SLSNZ.
4. You **MUST** notify your patrol captain if you cannot attend your patrol and try arrange a replacement patrolling member. The earlier you sort this out the easier it is for your patrol captain to help you find a replacement.
5. This year voluntary patrols fall on the main public holidays. You will note 2 patrols are rostered for each of these days. Do not assume there will be enough people to cover these days. Make sure you communicate with your patrol captain as to whether you can make it or not. Try and swap with someone else if possible. These weekends are renowned for large numbers at our popular beach. The more lifeguards we have the lighter the workload for everybody.
6. Each patrol is responsible for housekeeping duties at the Clubhouse. We have a great facility out there, so it needs to be kept tidy and clean by our members. Please do what you can to keep it in tip-top condition for all members to enjoy.
7. Bunkrooms at the Clubhouse are for all members to make use of - however, first priority is given to those rostered on patrol for the weekend. If it looks like there is not going to be enough room you may have to make other arrangements. Try calling Ben or the rostered patrol captain to arrange bedding arrangements.
